China Southern Launches Cargo Transfer Services to Europe via Shanghai

On 23rd December 2010, China Southern launched its international cargo transfer services from Seoul to Europe via Shanghai Pudong, marking the commencement of China Southern's international-to-international cargo transfer service at Shanghai. This new service enables China Southern to collect cargo items from Japan and Korea to Shanghai utilising the bellyhold capacity, and then transfer them to Europe or America by freighters.

To date, China Southern operates six international cargo services, with five destinations namely Amsterdam, Frankfurt, Vienna, Chicago and Los Angeles.
