**China Eastern Ranks Among Top Global Airbus 330 Operators
by Introducing the 50th Airbus 330**

China Eastern (CES) has received its 50th Airbus 330 aircraft in Shanghai and ordered another 15, making itself one of the biggest global Airbus 330 operators.

In 2006, CES introduced China's first Airbus 330 with a double-aisle configuration, which immediately became CES' major aircraft type in extending its mid-to-long distance flights. Currently, CES has 50 Airbus 330 aircraft including 32 330-200 models and 18 330-300 models. Moreover, about 230 single-aisle Airbus 320 are being used by CES.

Over recent years, CES has been introducing Airbus 330 and has operation bases in Shanghai, Beijing and Kunming, which are set to operate mid-to-long distance flights between China and regions including Europe, Oceania, the Middle East and Southeast Asia.
