China Southern, Xia'men Airlines and KLM Enhances Cooperation

On 26th March, witnessed by Dutch Prime Minister Mark Rutte, China Southern Airlines, Xia'men Airlines, and KLM signed an agreement to deepen alliance cooperation, announcing that the three airlines will strengthen the partnership in Sino-Dutch flights.

As member airlines of SkyTeam Alliance, the three air carriers operate six intercontinental flights in total: Amsterdam-Guangzhou (operated by China Southern), Amsterdam-Beijing (by China Southern and KLM), Amsterdam-Xia'men (by Xia'men Airlines and KLM), Amsterdam-Shanghai/Chengdu/Hangzhou (by KLM).
