New Summer/Autumn Schedule in Effect

From 29th March to 24th October, the 2015 Summer/Autumn schedule of Chinese civil aviation is in effect, which lasts a total of 210 days, or 30 weeks. In response to the national “One Belt and One Road” strategy, China Southern plans to launch a large number of new services to Southeast Asia and Africa, as well as increasing flights to Europe and America. The new season will see China Southern open more than 70 routes including 50 domestic ones and 20 international ones. By then, China Southern will operate a total of 2,000 daily flights on 900 routes to 190 destinations. Meanwhile, the latest aircraft such as Boeing 787 and Boeing 777-300ER will be deployed to international services.
